Project Idea



Scenario: The world has come to an end, leaving only a few people to help rebuild it. The brightest minds in history are aboard an airplane flying over the ruins. Suddenly the engine fails, and the plane begins to fall. There is only one parachute on the plane. Who should get to use the parachute, and lead the rebuilding of civilization?

Students engage in bracket-style debate to determine the greatest leader in history. Winners of each debate face other winners. Losing teams join winning teams as researchers.
